

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RADBOURNE LANE, LADBROOKE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Radbourne Lane, Ladbrooke from a point opposite the property known as The Willows, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate repairs to a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 21 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B4455 FOSSE WAY & WINDMILL HILL LANE, CHESTERTON AND TEMPORARY 40MPH SPEED RESTRICTION ORDER

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing B4455 Fosse Way, Chesterton from the junction at the B4100 roundabout northwards to the junction of Harbury Lane and Windmill Hill Lane, Chesterton at its junction with the Fosse Way, to vehicular traffic and a Temporary Traffic Order restricting the speed of traffic using the above named roads.

The closure and speed restriction are required in connection with carriageway resurfacing works.

Please note: The works will be carried out overnight between 20.00hrs and 06.00hrs nightly.

Please further note: When the works are not in progress, the road will be open to traffic however the speed of all traffic will be restricted to 40 mph, for the safety of all road users

The Orders will commence on 4 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 December 2017, weather permitting.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Banbury Road, Gaydon Road, Station Road, Deppers Bridge Road, Ufton Road, A425 Southam Road, Fosse Way and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH STREET, HARBURY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Church Street, Harbury to vehicular traffic.

The Order will commence on 18 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: The Bull Ring, Church Terrace, Hall Lane, Crown Street (and vice versa).
