

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RADBOURNE LANE, LADBROOKE**

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Radbourne Lane, Ladbroke from a point opposite the property known as The Willows, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate repairs to a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 21 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BUSH HEATH LANE, HARBURY**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Bush Heath Lane, Harbury from a point approximately 80 metres south of Hereburgh Way, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a duct in the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 4 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 January 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Bush Heath Lane, Butt Lane, Vicarage Lane, South Parade, Park Lane (and vice versa).
