ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (VARIATION A) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order pursuant to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below.

The Order commences on Monday 12 February 2018.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Order being varied, plans showing the lengths of roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick and at Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Leamington Spa during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Cherry Street, Warwick – No Waiting At Any Time

- (i) West side, from a point 55 metres north of its junction with Coton End, northwards for 22 metres.
- (ii) East side, from its junction with Coton End, northwards for 79 metres.

Cherry Street, Warwick – Limited Waiting, 2 hours no return 4 hours, 8 am - 8 pm, except permit holders (W3)

- (i) West side, from a point 24 metres north of its junction with Coton End, northwards for 31 metres.
- (ii) West Side, from a point 79 metres north of its junction with Coton End, northwards to a point 12 metres south of its junction with Guy's Cliffe Terrace.
- (iii) East side, from a point 79 metres north of its junction with Coton End, northwards to a point 14 metres south of its junction with Guy's Cliffe Terrace.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A423 SOUTHAM ROAD/LADBROKE BYPASS/BANBURY ROAD, LADBROKE (TO SOUTH BOUND TRAFFIC) and TEMPORARY 40MPH SPEED RESTRICTION A423 SOUTHAM ROAD/ LADBROKE BYPASS/BANBURY ROAD, LADBROKE and TEMPORARY 10MPH SPEED RESTRICTION (NORTH BOUND TRAFFIC) A423 SOUTHAM ROAD/LADBROKE BYPASS/ BANBURY ROAD, LADBROKE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make Temporary Traffic Orders closing the A423 Southam Road/Ladbroke Bypass/Banbury Road, Ladbroke from a point 100m North of C140 Banbury Road (north end), Ladbroke to a point 200m South of C140 Banbury Road (south end) to south bound vehicular traffic and restricting the speed of all vehicles as indicated below) on A423 Southam Road/Ladbroke Bypass/Banbury Road, Ladbroke

THE RESURFACING WORKS ARE BEING CARRIED OUT OVERNIGHT BETWEEN 20.00HRS AND 06.00HRS NIGHTLY AND THE ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC.

A 10MPH SPEED RESTRICTION WILL APPLY TO NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC OVERNIGHT WHILST THE CONTRACTORS ARE WORKING IN THE CARRIAGEWAY.

THE ROAD WILL BE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE DAY TIME WHEN WORK IS NOT IN PROGRESS AND A 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION WILL BE IN FORCE AND APPLIES TO ALL TRAFFIC TRAVELLING IN BOTH A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works; the speed restrictions are for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working in the carriageway whilst the road is being resurfaced.

The Orders will commence on 28 February 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

Alternative routes will be signed and are available via:

Southbound Diversion: A423 Southam Bypass, A425 Daventry Road, A425 Southam Road, A425 Shuckburgh Road, A425 Napton Road, A425 Main Street, A425 Park Hill, A425 Daventry Road, A425 Daventry Road, A45 Stefan Way, A361 Badby Road West, A361 High Street, A361 Banbury Road, A361 Byefield Road, A361 Banbury Road, A361 Williamscoth Hill.

Local Diversion: A425 Leamington Road, B4451 Kineton Road, Harbury Road, Church Road and vice versa.
