ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 & 14(1) TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A425 DAVENTRY ROAD, SOUTHAM & A425 SOUTHAM ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL AND TEMPORARY 40MPH SPEED RESTRICTION A425 DAVENTRY ROAD, SOUTHAM & A425 SOUTHAM ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL)

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make Temporary Traffic Orders closing A425 Daventry Road, Southam & A425 Southam Road, Napton on the Hill from a point 50 metres east to a point 375metres west of the junction with Brickyard Lane, to vehicular traffic and restricting the speed of all vehicles on A425 Daventry Road, Southam & A425 Southam Road, Napton on the Hill from the speed limit signs east of Calcutt Meadow to the speed limit signs west of the property known as Westcott House.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works; the speed restriction is for the safety of all road users whilst the road is being resurfaced.

The Orders will commence on 8 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16 March 2018.

Please note: The resurfacing works are being carried out overnight between 20.00hrs and 06.00hrs nightly however the speed restriction will be in force 24 hours a day until completion of the resurfacing works.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: A425 Daventry Road, A423 Southam Bypass, A426 Southam Road, Daventry Road, A45 Daventry Road, A45 London Road, A45 Braunston Road, A45 Leamington Way, A425 Daventry Road, A425 Park Hill, A425 Napton Road, A425 Shuckburgh Road, A425 Southam Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GAYDON ROAD, BISHOPS ITCHINGTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Gaydon Road, Bishops Itchington from the junction of Plough Lane to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate the construction of traffic calming measures.

The Order will commence on 4 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on Sunday 4 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: B4451 Station Road, B4452 Deppers Bridge Road, B4452 Ufton Road, A425 Southam Road, A425 Ufton Hill, B4455 Fosse Way, B4100 Banbury Road, B4451 Gaydon Road (and vice versa).
