

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BULL STREET, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Bull Street, Southam, from a point outside property number 4, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate repairs to a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 29 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Craven Lane, Pendicke Street, Daventry Road, Daventry Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GODSONS LANE, NAPTON ON THE HILL
