Notice for variation to a Premises Licence

We, Pars Bars Ltd hereby gives notice that an application was made to Warwick District Council on 26th April 2018 for a variation to the premises licence at The New Bowling Green, 13 St Nicholas, Church Street, Warwick, Warwickshire, CV34 4JD for the following structural variation: The introduction of a new section of bar counter to improve customer service, provide a better back-fitting and create a dedicated coffee station. This reduces the current trading area by approximately 2.8m².

A new garden bottle-bar server is proposed within the existing out-building, enabling the removal of the temporary shed structure from the adjacent paved area.

Works within the toilet area include the raising of the Gents floor to remove the current steps and trip hazard.

There are a number of fixed seating runs proposed within the general bar areas.

We are also proposing to replace the external bench seating and create two seating booths.

Minor changes are proposed to the rear garden entrance (off the footpath) and the existing bins are to be relocated to improve the overall garden vision. All areas will be refurbished and redecorated. Externally, the property will be repainted and new signage applied.

Full details of the proposals are stated on the application for variation. The full application may be inspected at Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Leamington Spa, CV32 5HZ free of charge during office hours.

Any interested party or responsible authority may make written representations by 24th May 2018

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application and a person may be liable to a fine on summary conviction of up to £5,000.
