ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WELSH ROAD, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Welsh Road, Southam to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of BT poles.

The Order will commence on 31 May 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 June 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Welsh Road, Hardwick Road, Main Road, The Green, Southam Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6046 CHURCH TERRACE & D6048 HALL LANE, HARBURY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6046 Church Terrace & D6048 Hall Lane, Harbury from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Hall Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for street lighting, sign replacement and painting.

The Order will commence on 11 June 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 June 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: D6046 Church Terrace & D6048 Hall Lane, Harbury.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C51 KNIGHTCOTE ROAD & D6396 KNIGHTCOTE BOTTOM, KNIGHTCOTE

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C51 Knightcote Road & D6396 Knightcote Bottom, Knightcote from the junction of C51 Knightcote Road and D6396 Knightcote Bottom, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order commenced on 12 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier. Unfortunately the works could not be completed at that time but have now been scheduled for 28 and 29 May 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.00hrs and 15.30hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

Via – Knightcote Road, Gaydon Road, Knightcote Bottom and vice versa
