

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6046 CHURCH TERRACE & D6048 HALL LANE, HARBURY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6046 Church Terrace & D6048 Hall Lane, Harbury from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Hall Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for street lighting, sign replacement and painting.

The Order will commence on 11 June 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 June 2018.

Please note: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HIGH STREET, BISHOPS ITCHINGTON

The closure is required to facilitate utility works.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HALL LANE, HARBURY
