

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
VICARAGE LANE, PRIORS MARSTON**

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Vicarage Lane, Priors Marston from a point adjacent to The Malt Kiln to a point outside Plum Tree Cottage, to vehicular traffic.
