## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2308 HILLSIDE, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Traffic Order closing D2308 Hillside, Napton on the Hill, from Butt Hill to Daventry Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate footway reconstruction works.

The Order will commence on 17 September 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 September 2018.

**PLEASE NOTE:** the works will be carried out between 08.00hrs and 17.00hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Butt Hill, Daventry Road and vice versa.

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WELSH ROAD EAST, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Welsh Road East, Southam from a point outside the new Taylor Wimpey site, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for a HV Electricity connection.

The Order will commence on 3 September 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 September 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Welsh Road East, Daventry Road, Southam Road, Butt Hill, Vicarage Road, School Hill, Hackwell Street, High Street, New Street, Chapel Green Road, Thorntons Lane, Napton Holt Road, Holt Road (and vice versa).

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CRAVEN LANE, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Craven Lane, Southam, between property numbers 7 and 11, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 17 September 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19 September 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Craven Lane, Pendicke Street, Oxford Street, Market Hill, Daventry Street, Bull Street.
