

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SM56 IN THE PARISH OF NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath SM56 in the Parish of Napton on the Hill between grid references SP:45718-60388 and SP:45982-60634, to all traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public whilst works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near to the path.

The Order will commence on 5 November 2018 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 January 2019.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Public Footpaths SM56a, SM56b and Folly Lane.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C97 BASCOTE ROAD, BASCOTE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C97 Bascote Road, Bascote between Welsh Road and Pudding Bag Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate structural carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 5 November 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 November 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs and the road will be open outside of these hours.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FARM STREET, HARBURY

TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT – B4451 STATION ROAD, BISHOPS ITCHINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed limit of 30 mph on the above named road, from a point approximately 150 metres south of the existing Walworth Farm/Western Power electricity substation access to a point approximately 120 metres north of existing Bishop Bowl Fishery access (as indicated by signage).

The temporary speed limit is required for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on or near to the carriageway on the construction of highway works.

The Order will commence on 22 October 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 February 2019.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NAPTON HOLT ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Napton Holt Road, Napton on the Hill from a point outside Headlands Farmhouse, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a sluice valve.
