ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SM21 IN THE PARISH OF SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath SM21 in the Parish of Southam between Grid Reference SP41397-61743 to SP41281-61727 to all traffic.
