

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2316 MARSTON DOLES ROAD, NAPTON-ON-THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2316 Marston Doles Road, Napton-on-the Hill, from its junction with Marston Doles/Meadow Gate to its junction with Napton Holt Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate drainage works.

The Order will commence on 21 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 February 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Marston Doles, Welsh Road, Southam Road, The Holloway, Shuckburgh Road, Priors Marston Road, Dog Lane, New Street, Chapel Green Road, Thorntons Lane and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2356 SPRINGS CRESCENT, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2356 Springs Crescent, Southam from its junction with Welsh Road West to the first junction of Springs Crescent, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

PLEASE NOTE: The work will be carried out between 09.00hrs and 15.30hrs.

The Order will commence on 8 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DAVENTRY ROAD, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Daventry Road, Southam from a point east of its junction with Calcutt Meadow to a point approximately 450 metres east of the Tarsus Hotel, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway works.

The Order will commence on 21 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STOCKTON ROAD, LONG ITCHINGTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Stockton Road, Long Itchington, from a point approximately 300 metres east of the centre line of its junction with Meadow Drive to a point approximately 10 metres south of Stockton Canal Bridge, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for widening of the carriageway on the bend and construction of an adjacent footpath.

The Order will commence on 21 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 February 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Stockton Road, Southam Road, Coventry Road (and vice versa).
