

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SNOWFORD HILL, LONG ITCHINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Snowford Hill, Long Itchington, between its junction with Leamington Road and Ridgeway Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate excavation works to enable connection of new water plots onto the mains.

The Order will commence on 19 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 February 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BULL STREET, SOUTHAM
