ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WELSH ROAD EAST, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Welsh Road East, Southam, from a point outside the development site entrance, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate excavation works to enable the installation connection of water pipes to the mains.

The Order will commence on 11 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 March 2019.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, FRANKTON ROAD & BIRDINGBURY ROAD. BIRDINGBURY
