

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2335 STONEBRIDGE LANE, C91 LONG ITCHINGTON ROAD & C91 LEAMINGTON ROAD (ALSO KNOWN AS SNOWFORD HILL), LONG ITCHINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2335 Stonebridge Lane, C91 Long Itchington Road & C91 Leamington Road (also known as Snowford Hill), Long Itchington to vehicular traffic as indicated below.

The closures are required to safely enable works on the bridges.

The Order will commence on 18 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 March 2019.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs and the road will be open outside of these times.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOMLOW ROAD, STOCKTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Tomlow Road, Stockton to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a boundary box in the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 20 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 March 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Tomlow Road, Stockton Road, Napton Road, Station Road (and vice versa).
