**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B4452
UFTON ROAD, WELSH ROAD &
BASCOTE ROAD, UFTON**

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing B4452 Ufton Road, Welsh Road & Bascote Road, Ufton to vehicular traffic. However, the extent of the closure of B4452 Ufton Road closed has now been changed as indicated in the Table below. All other details remain the same.

Bascote Road	Between the junction of A425 Southam Road and the junction of Welsh Road	3 January 2020 To 8 March 2020	Bascote Road, Southam Road, Ufton Hill, Fosse Way, Welsh Road (and vice versa)

The closures are required to facilitate works for the connection of a new power supply for a tunnel boring machine.

The Order commenced on 10 July 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
