

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6063 HEBER DRIVE, HARBURY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6063 Heber Drive, Harbury, from its junction with Mill Street to its junction with Knightlow Way, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for carriageway patching. The Order will commence on 11 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 09.30 and 15.30 on 11 September 2019. Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SCHOOL LANE, LADBROKE
