ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984. SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6071 OLD

GATED ROAD, CHESTERTON Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary

Traffic Order closing D6071 Old Gated Boad. Chesterton from its jct. with Church Road to outside the Mill House, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for drainage and associated works. (0800 to 1700 Weekdays only).

The Order will commence on 16 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 September 2019.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHUCKBURGH ROAD, PRIORS MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Shuckburgh Road, Priors Marston, from a point opposite "Norwind," to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to safely facilitate utility works in the footway.

The Order will commence on 16 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, However, it is anticipated that the works will be
