ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D6447 ST. PETERS ROAD, D6449 MILL CRESCENT, D6446 MILL LANE, D6452 HANBURY CLOSE & D6448 SEGRAVE CLOSE, KINETON

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic: D6447 St Peters Road – in its entirety from Southam Road to Mill Crescent; D6449 Mill Crescent – in its entirety from St Peters Road to Mill Lane; D6446 Mill Lane – from Mill Crescent to Shortacres and Mill Street; D6452 Hanbury Close – in its entirety & D6448 Segrave Close – in its entirety.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing & associated works, 09.00 -15.30, week days only.

Order Commences: 19 November 2019 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 27 November 2019.

Access & Diversion: Banbury Street, Southam Street, Southam Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
