ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

A425 SHUCKBURGH ROAD & A425 PARK HILL, SHUCKBURGH

Order Effect: A 40mph speed restriction will be imposed between the existing 40mph signage near The Paddocks and the existing 40mph signage near to Wigrams Turn Marina.

Reason for Order: For the safety of all road users and of the Contractors working on the carriageway.

Order Commences: 21 June 2020 for up to 18 months.

COVENTRY ROAD, SOUTHAM

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside the substation.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for a new clean water connection.

Order Commences: 22 June 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 25 June 2020.

Access & Diversion: Coventry Road, Southam Road, Rugby Road, London Road, A45 J M45/B4429 roundabout, A45 from J M45/B4429 to JA4071/B4453 W, A45 from J A4071/B4453 to J B4455 W, A45 J B4455 roundabout, Fosse Way, Oxford Road, Station Road, Marton Road, The Green and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BASCOTE ROAD, SOUTHAM

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Bascote Bridge to a point approximately 230 metres north of its junction with Manor House Lane.

Reason for Order: To facilitate utility works.

Order Commences: 6 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 10 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Bascote Road, Welsh Road West, Welsh Road, Tomwell Close, Coventry Street, Coventry Road, Southam Road, The Green, Church Road and vice versa.

D2303 BRICKYARD ROAD (also known as BRICKYARD LANE & OLD BRICKYARD LANE) AND D2306 POPLAR ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside Baird Park Industrial Estate to the junction with Howcombe Gardens.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing and associated works.

Order Commences: 8 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day between 08.00hrs - 17.00hrs on 8 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Brickyard Lane (Old Brickyard Lane), A425 Southam Road, Butt Hill, Vicarage Road, Hackwell Street, High Street, New Street, Howcombe Lane and vice versa.

Contractor: Balfour Beatty, Tel: 03452 415302.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
