### NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER – HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

### WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### (PART OF FOOTPATH R89 HARBOROUGH MAGNA) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020

On 20 October 2020 Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will **DIVERT** the full length and width of that section of Public Footpath R89 from Point A through the domestic gardens of Le Verger and the dwelling of Campden (grid reference 447549 - 279311) to point B (grid reference 447517 - 279388) a total distance of approx. 86 metres as shown on the Order Plan, **TO A LINE** from Point A (grid reference 447549 - 279311) running generally East for approx. 30 metres to Point C (grid reference 447582 - 279317), before continuing generally North-north west for approx. 87 metres to point D (grid reference 447555 - 279402) a total distance of approx. 117 metres as shown on the Order Plan.

The new route shall have an available width of 3 metres.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order Plan have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Warwickshire County Council, Shire Hall, Market Square, Warwick CV34 4SA from 8am - 5.30pm on weekdays, (5pm Fridays) and 9am - 4pm Saturdays. A copy of the Order and Order Plan may be bought there at the price of £5.77. Copies may also be inspected at the offices of the Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Evreux Way, Rugby, CV21 2RR between 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday - Friday and online at [www.warwickshire.gov.uk/pathorders](http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/pathorders).

The Order comes into force on 27 October 2020 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 22 October 2020 make an application to the High Court.
