ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

NAPTON ROAD, STOCKTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between points 60 metres north and 40 metres south of the canal bridge.

Reason for Order: To safely enable the replacement of a decaying BT pole, 09.30hrs-15.00hrs.

Order Commences: 13 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 13 November 2020.

Access & Diversion: Stockton Road, Napton Road, Southam Road, Coventry Road, Southam By-Pass, Daventry Road, Butt Hill and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

TOMLOW ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for new water connections.

Order Commences: 30 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 2 December 2020.

Access & Diversion: Tomlow Road, Napton Road, Gibraltar Lane, Hospital Lane, Southam Road, Rugby Road, Coventry Road, Southam Bypass, Daventry Road, Butt Hill and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
