ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C33 NAPTON ROAD/STOCKTON ROAD, NAPTON-ON-THE HILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Tomlow Road and Station Road.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 09.00hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commences: 26 January 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 28 January 2021.

Access & Diversion: Station Road, Napton Road, Tomlow Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
