ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BIGGIN HALL LANE, THURLASTON, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Main Street for approximately 200 metres.

Reason for Order: To safely enable works for the replacement of a BT pole.

Order Commences: 1 March 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 1 March 2021.

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction of Brindley Road.

Reason for Order: To enable works on a water pipe.

LITTLE LAWFORD LANE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To safely enable tree cutting works.

Order Commences: 15 March 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 15 March 2021.

Access & Diversion: Little Lawford Lane, Cathiron Lane, Rugby Road, Fosse Way, Newnham Lane, Bretford Road, Little Lawford Road and vice versa.

RAILWAY STREET, LONG LAWFORD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with School Street and Main Street.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of safety kerbs.

Anticipated Completion: 26 March 2021.

Access & Diversion: Main Street, Baileys Lane and School Street. Access to adjacent properties only will be managed by Traffic Management Operatives.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
