THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A426 LEICESTER ROAD) (DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to de-restrict the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below.
