ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

A426 LEICESTER ROAD, D3061 NEWTON MANOR LANE, D7344 LOWER LODGE AVENUE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Leicester Road closed to vehicular traffic between the roundabout at the junctions of Brownsover Road & Boughton Road, the roundabout at the junctions of Newton Manor Lane & Lower Lodge Avenue and the roundabout at the junctions of Central Park Drive & Overview Way. D3061 Newton Manor Lane and D7344 Lower Lodge Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic. The One-way traffic flow in Brownsover Lane will be temporarily suspended.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing and associated works, overnight 20.00hrs-06.00hrs.

Order Commences: 21 April 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 28 April 2022.

Access & Diversion: Main Route: A426, A4071, A45, Coventry Road, Daventry Road, A45, A361, A5, A426 and vice versa. For Lower Lodge Avenue. Brownover Lane and vice versa. For Newton Manor Lane (traffic under 7.5T): Boughton Road, Butlers Leap, Clifton Road, Rugby Road, Main Street, Church Street, Newton Road, Newton Manor Lane and vice versa.

ASHLAWN ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside property number 45 to its junction with Hillmorton Road.

Reason for Order: To enable remedial works, overnight closures.

Order Commences: 19 April 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 22 April 2022.

Access & Diversion: Hillmorton Road, Lawrence Sheriff Street, Dunchurch Road, Ashlawn Road and vice versa.

BACK LANE, BIRDINGBURY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: Excavation works to enable inspection of a possible collapsed storm drain.

Access & Diversion: Back Lane, Leamington Hastings Road, Main Street and vice versa.

EVEREST ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Access & Diversion: Everest Road, Shakespeare Gardens, Overslade Lane and vice versa.
