ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BOURTON LANE, BIRDINGBURY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable trenching works for installation of a new power supply.

Order Commences: 13 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 14 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Bourton Lane, Birdingbury Road, Main Street, Frankton Road, Bourton Road and vice versa.

LITTLE ELBOROW STREET, RUGBY

Order Effect: All traffic will be prohibited from making a right turn from Elborow Street on to Corporation Street.

Reason for Order: For the safety of all road users.

Order Commences: 13 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 August 2022.

Access & Diversion: Corporation Street, Warwick Street, Dunchurch Road, Russelsheim Way, Bilton Road.

MAIN STREET, BROADWELL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with The Row and Hospital Lane.

Reason for Order: To enable excavation works for the replacement of a sewer.

Order Commences: 11 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 26 July 2022.

Access & Diversion: Hayway Lane, Flecknoe Road, Southam Road, Hospital Lane and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D3575 PLEXFIELD ROAD & HILLFIELD ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction of Bilton Road to a point outside property number 35 Hillfield Road.

Reason for Order: Footway reconstruction and associated works, 08.00hrs-17.00hrs weekdays only.

Order Commences: 27 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 22 July 2022.

Access & Diversion: Hillfield Road, Wheatfield Avenue, Adison Road, Bilton Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
