#### (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 20 mph speed limit on the lengths of road described in the Schedule below.

#### SCHEDULE

##### 1. Daventry Street, Southam

From the back of footway on the eastern side of Market Hill, eastwards for a distance of 8 metres.

##### 2. Meadow Road, Southam

From the back of footway on the eastern side of Coventry Street, eastwards for a distance of 18 metres.

##### 3. Oxford Street/Market Hill/High Street/Coventry Street (including the junction of Warwick Street), Southam

From a point in Oxford Street which is situate 44 metres north-west of its junction with Pendicke Street (measured from a point in line with the back of footway on the south-eastern side of Pendicke Street), northwards through Oxford Street, Market Hill, High Street and Coventry Street for a total distance of 590 metres in length.

##### 4. Park Lane, Southam

From the back of footway on the western side of Market Hill, north-westwards for a distance of 22 metres.

##### 5. Welsh Road West, Southam

From the back of footway on the western side of Coventry Street, westwards for a distance of 9.5 metres.
