

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSAL TO INCREASE THE CAPACITY TO 420 PUPILS AND ESTABLISH SPECIALIST RESOURCED PROVISION AT ST JOHN'S PRIMARY SCHOOL
