

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AL47 IN THE PARISH OF ARROW

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpaths AL47 in the Parish of Arrow at grid references SP08452-56646 to all traffic.

The closure is required because of the dangerous dilapidated condition of the bridge.

The Order will commence on 25 February 2016 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AL131 IN THE PARISH OF STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpaths AL131 in the Parish of Studley at grid references: SP04936-63736, to all traffic.

The closure is required because of the dangerous condition of the bridge.

The Order will commence on 25 February 2016 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Public Footpath AL131c, Evesham Rd and Public Footpath AL131.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C100 CHURCH BANK, TEMPLE GRAFTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C100 Church Bank, Temple Grafton from Main Road to New Road, to vehicular traffic.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A422 ARROW LANE, ARROW

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing A422 Arrow Lane, Arrow from Arrow Lane to Main Street to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate reconstruction & resurfacing of the footway.

The Order will commence on 24 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 March 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
