

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AL131 IN THE PARISH OF STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpaths AL131 in the Parish of Studley, at grid references: SP04936-63736, to all traffic.

The closure is required because of the dangerous and dilapidated condition of the bridge.

The Order will commence on 17 November 2016 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Public Footpath AL131c, Evesham Rd and Public Footpath AL131.

TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTION HENLEY ROAD, GREAT ALNE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed restriction of 30 mph on the above named road as it leaves the village of Great Alne in an easterly direction, as indicated by signage.

The temporary speed restriction is required for reasons of public safety to reduce the likelihood of danger to the public or to road users due to the proximity of a site entrance of the development on Henley Road.

The Order will commence on 18 November 2016 and will last for a period of up to 18 months, or until the works to which it relates are completed, whichever is the earlier.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 90A PROPOSED ROAD HUMPS – KINWARTON FARM ROAD, ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council propose, pursuant to section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to install the raised features/road humps as described in the Schedule below for the purpose of reducing vehicle speeds.

A copy of the plan showing the location of the proposed raised features/road humps may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at the Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford upon Avon; and at the Alcester Library & One Stop Shop, Globe House, Priory Road, Alcester during usual opening hours. Kinwarton Farm Road, Alcester:

- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 32 metres north of its junction with Captain's Hill;
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 34 metres north of its southern junction with Seymour Road;
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 36 metres north of its junction with Kinnersley Road;
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 35 metres south of its junction with Glebe Road;
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 84 metres south of its junction with Glebe Road;
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 23 metres north of its junction with Glebe Road;
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 16 metres north of its northern junction with Seymour Road; and
- 2 No. 75mm high speed cushion to be located approximately 67 metres north of its northern junction with Seymour Road.
