

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PRATTS LANE, MAPPLEBOROUGH GREEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Pratts Lane, Mappleborough Green, at a point near to the property known as Byanna, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of a new gas supply.

The Order will commence on 19 December 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 December 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Pratts Lane, Birmingham Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BURFORD LANE, SHELFIELD, ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Burford Lane, Shelfield, Alcester to vehicular traffic.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C39 WHITEHOUSE HILL, LITTLE ALNE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C39 Whitehouse Hill, Little Alne, from the junction with Bearley Road to the junction with Alcester Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for parapet maintenance.

The Order will commence on 5 December 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 14 December 2016.

Please Note: The work will be carried out daily between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
