ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS WIXFORD)

(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to impose a 30mph speed limit on the lengths of roads mentioned in the Schedule below.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire CV37 6HX and at the Public Library, 14 Rother St, Stratford-upon-Avon CV37 6LU during usual opening hours.

SCHEDULE (30mph speed limit)

Ryknild Street

From its junction with centre line of Church Lane southwards for a distance of 259m.

Grafton Road

That length of Grafton Road which extends from its junction with Ryknild Street in an easterly then south-easterly direction for a distance of 430m.

Exhall Road

That length of Exhall Road which extends in a north-easterly direction from its junction with Grafton Road for a distance of 127m.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SD272C IN THE PARISH OF TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath SD272c in the Parish of Tanworth in Arden at Grid Reference SP08895-73209, to all traffic.

The closure is required to avoid a likelihood of danger to the public as the result of the dilapidated and dangerous condition of the bridge along its route.

The Order will commence on 25 February 2017 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MORTON BAGOT ROAD, OUTHILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Morton Bagot Road, Outhill between its junctions with Redditch Road and Hardwick Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 15 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Redditch Road, Hardwick Lane and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ICKNIELD ROW, ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Icknield Row, Alcester, from its junction with Birmingham Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 13 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
