ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KINGS LANE, BROOM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Kings Lane, Broom to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a stop tap.

The Order will commence on 15 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AL38B IN THE PARISH OF ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath AL38b in the Parish of Alcester, between grid references SP09713-56970 to SP09917-56933, to all traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public as a result of the severe erosion to the riverbank along which it runs.

The Order will commence on 5 April 2017 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Stratford Road and Public Footpath AL38a.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AL145 IN THE PARISH OF STUDLEY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH ROAD, ULLENHALL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Church Road, Ullenhall to vehicular traffic.

The Order will commence on 28 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 28 March 2017.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Oldberrow Road, Henley Road, Oldberrow Lane, Green Lanes, Grimshaw Hill, Barrells Park, Ullenhall Road (and vice versa).
