ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CROFT LANE, TEMPLE GRAFTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Croft Lane, Temple Grafton from a point adjacent to properties number 1 to 5 Croft Court, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of a new clean water supply.

The Order will commence on 13 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 November 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Croft Lane, Church Bank, Grafton Lane, Haselor Hill, A46 from jct. with A435 to jct. of A422, Stratford Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C41 WOOD LANE, HASELOR

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C41 Wood Lane, Haselor from the junction with Pelham Lane to the junction with Walcote Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the replacement of fencing.

The Order will commence on 30 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 October 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Pelham Lane, Walcote Road and vice versa.
