ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HARDWICK LANE, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Hardwick Lane, Studley from a point opposite the rear of 1 Hollyoake, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a duct and building of a box.

The Order will commence on 1 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 14 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Hardwick Lane, Castle Road, Alcester Road, Priory Square, Birmingham Road, Henley Road, Morton Bagot Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AL38B IN THE PARISH OF ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath AL38b in the Parish of Alcester from grid references SP09713-56970 to SP09917-56933 to all traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of the severe erosion of the river bank.

The Order will commence on 21 November 2017 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Stratford Road and Public Footpath AL38a.
