TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of an Order made under Section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highway (West Midlands) (No. 1) Order 2018" authorising the stopping up of a southern part width of Priory Farm Lane comprising its highway verge adjoining Oak Barn at Inkberrow in the District of Wychavon to enable development as permitted by Wychavon District Council, under reference W/16/00421/CU.

Any person aggrieved by or desiring to question the validity of or any provision within the Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement or regulation made has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks of 19 January 2018 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision included.
