

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D51310 GENTLEMANS LANE, ULLENHALL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D51310 Gentlemans Lane, Ullenhall from Forde Hall Lane to Moat Farm Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C100 VILLAGE ROAD, RED HILL

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AL145 IN THE PARISH OF STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath AL145 in the Parish of Studley between grid references SP08648-64070 and SP08899-64308 to all traffic.

The closure was required because works were being or were proposed to be executed on or near to the highway.

The Order commenced on 29 March 2017 for a period of 6 months. Following direction from the Secretary of State the closure period was extended to continue in force until 29 March 2018, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has now directed that the Order shall continue in force until 5 December 2018 or until completion of the works, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State extends the Order by a further direction).

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route is available and will be signed.
