## WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHAPEL LANE, ULLENHALL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Chapel Lane, Ullenhall to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate overhead utility works.

The Order will commence on 23 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ALCESTER) (20 MPH ZONE) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2018

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above Variation Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the 20 mph zone in Alcester by including the lengths of road which are described in the Schedule below.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of an Order to be varied, a plan showing the lengths of road affected and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make these changes may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Stratford-upon-Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire and at Alcester Library and Information Centre, Globe House, Priory Road, Alcester during usual opening hours.

### SCHEDULE

1. The entire lengths of:-  
Beacon Close, Bulls Head Yard, Chapman Way, Crooks Lane (all lengths), Gunnings Road, Moorfield Road, Old Rectory Garden, Ropewalk and St Nicholas Close.
2. Hertford Road – from Crooks Lane, north-westwards for 46 metres
3. School Road – from a point 40 metres north-east of Priory Road, north-eastwards then eastwards to Henley Street (being a distance of approximately 450 metres)
4. St. Faith's Road – from Crooks Lane, westwards then north-westwards to a point 26 metres south-east of Vallet Avenue (being a distance of approximately 415 metres).
