Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath AL148 in the Parish of Morton Bagot at Grid Reference SP10052-64/20 to all traffic

The dosure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of the dangerous dilapidated condition of the bridge along its route. The Order will commence on 21 December 2018 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial

works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF REDHILL ROAD, ALCESTER Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a

Temporary Traffic Order closing Redhill Road, Alcester, from the junction with A46 Alcester Road to a point approximately 200m in a southerly direction, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate safe access to the overhead network to enable a new connection.

The Order will commence on 9 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 9 January 2019.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Redhill Road, Village Road, A46 From J A435 To J A422, Alcester Road (and vice versa).
