ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH PLOVER CLOSE, ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing the Public Footpath Plover Close, Alcester, between Plover Close and Springfields Road, to all traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to repair a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 21 February 2019 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 February 2019.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROOM LANE, DUNNINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Broom Lane, Dunnington to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate utility works on the existing mains.

The Order will commence on 16 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 February 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Broom Lane, Salford Road, School Road, Station Road, A46 J B439 Roundabout, Norton Lenchwick Bypass, Howard Close, Inner Relief Road, Tower Hill, Waterloo Road, Ryknild Street, Mill Lane, Bidford Road, High Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROWLAND AVENUE, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Rowland Avenue, Studley, from a point outside property number 19, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate utility works in the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 4 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 March 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Rowland Avenue, Toms Town Lane, Alcester Road, Watts Road, Allendale Crescent (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SD22 IN THE PARISH OF TEMPLE GRAFTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath SD22 in the Parish of Temple Grafton, at Grid Reference SP130523, to all traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public as the result of the dangerous dilapidated condition of a bridge along its route.

The Order will commence on 19 February 2019 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained.

Please use an alternative route.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C215 WIXFORD ROAD, ARROW

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C215 Wixford Road, Arrow, from its junction with Dunnington Road to the Wixford River Bridge (just past the access to The Fish Inn), to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for road markings/studs and signing

The Order will commence on 4 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 March 2019.

PLEASE NOTE: It is anticipated that works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs each day and that the road will re-open outside of these hours.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Dunnington Road, Broom Lane, High Street, Bidford Road, Mill Lane, Ryknild Street, Wixford Road and vice versa.
