ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, HASELOR, ALCESTER) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30mph speed limit on the lengths of roads mentioned in the Schedule below.

(30 mph Speed Limit) 1. Pelham Lane

From its junction with Lower Haselor Lane/Walcote Road/Pelham Lane in a north westerly direction for

a distance of 52 metres. 2. Lower Haselor Lane (ii) From its junction with Lower Haselor Lane/Walcote Road/Pelham Lane in a westerly direction for

distance of 176 metres.

Walcote Road (iii) From its junction with Lower Haselor Lane/Walcote Road/Pelham Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 120 metres.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF EVESHAM ROAD, SALFORD PRIORS

County Council proposes to make a Warwickshire Temporary Traffic Order closing Evesham Road, Salford Priors, from a point outside property number 7, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate excavation works within the carriageway to enable the installation of water pipes for connection to the mains. The Order will commence on 23 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 April 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Evesham Road, School Road, Salford Road, New Inn Lane (and vice versa).
