ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MIDDLETOWN LANE, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Middletown Lane, Studley to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for utility works.

The Order will commence on 29 July 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 August 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Middletown Lane, The Green, Sambourne Lane, Oak Tree Lane, Jill Lane, The Slough, Node Hill, Bromsgrove Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HAYE LANE, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Haye Lane, Studley between Rose Court and Brookfield House, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to enable replacement of a defective manhole cover and frame.

The Order will commence on 16 July 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 16 July 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Henley Road, Birminoham Road, Have Lane (and vice versal)
