

## LICENSING ACT 2003 – PUBLIC NOTICE APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A PREMISES LICENCE

The **Astwood Bank Club** has applied to Redditch Borough Council for the grant of a premises licence in respect of **The Astwood Bank Club, 5 Dark Lane, Astwood Bank, Redditch, B96 6AS.**
