

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PELHAM LANE, HASELOR**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Pelham Lane, Haselor, from its jct. with Wood Lane to its jct. with Walcote Road/Lower Haselor Lane, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for utility works.

The Order will commence on 16 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 September 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Pelham Lane, Wood Lane, Walcote Road (and vice versa).

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5434 LOWER HASELOR LANE, HASELOR**

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5434 Lower Haselor Lane, Haselor, from the junction of Pelham Lane to o/s Wayfield, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for footway construction works, 9.30 - 15.30 week days only.

The Order will commence on 2 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 September 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lower Haselor Lane, Trench Lane, A46 Stratford Road, Pelham Lane and vice versa.

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5422 RIDDELL CLOSE, KINWARTON, ALCESTER**

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5422 Riddell Close, Kinwarton, Alcester from its junction with Winchcombe Road to its junction with Throckmorton Road, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for footway reconstruction, 0800 - 1700 hrs weekdays only.

The Order will commence on 2 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 September 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Winchcombe Road, Throckmorton Road and vice versa.

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH BETWEEN CROOKS LANE AND LANSDOWNE ROAD, STUDLEY**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing the Public Footpath between Crooks Lane and Lansdowne Road, Studley to all traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public while equipment replacement and excavation works in connection with the electricity substation are in progress.

The Order will commence on 19 September 2019 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 October 2019.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lansdowne Road, Highfield Road, Station Road, Crooks Lane (and vice versa).

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, HASELOR, ALCESTER) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019**

Warwickshire County Council have made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30mph speed limit on the lengths of roads mentioned in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the lengths of roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Stratford-On-Avon District Council, and at the Alcester Public Library, Globe house, Priory Road, Alcester B49 5DX during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

### **SCHEDULE**

#### **(30 mph Speed Limit)**

1. Pelham Lane
  - (i) From its junction with Lower Haselor Lane/Walcote Road/Pelham Lane in a north westerly direction for a distance of 52 metres.
2. Lower Haselor Lane
  - (i) From its junction with Lower Haselor Lane/Walcote Road/Pelham Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 176 metres.
3. Walcote Road
  - (i) From its junction with Lower Haselor Lane/Walcote Road/Pelham Lane in a easterly direction for a distance of 120 metres.
