

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5357 KINGS COUGHTON LANE, ALCESTER

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5357 Kings Coughton Lane, Alcester from Jct. A435 Birmingham Road to Jct. B4090 Alcester Heath to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for carriageway patching.

The Order will commence on 17 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: A435 Birmingham Road, B4090 Alcester Heath and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HAYE LANE, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Haye Lane, Studley, between Rose Court and Brookfield House, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for the replacement of a defective manhole cover and frame.

The Order will commence on 14 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 14 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Haye Lane, Birmingham Road, Henley Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HARDWICK LANE, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Hardwick Lane, Studley between Castle Farm and Orchard House, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to safely facilitate tree cutting works, 9.30 - 15.30 daily.

The Order will commence on 1 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Hardwick Lane, Castle Road, Alcester Road, Priors Square, Birmingham Road, Henley Road, Morton Bagot Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GRAFTON ROAD, WIXFORD

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Grafton Road, Wixford to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for works to build a precast chamber and install polyduct in verge, footway and carriageway.

The Order will commence on 27 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 14 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Grafton Road, Ryknild Street, Georges Elm Lane (and vice versa).
