

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D5143 PRATTS LANE, MAPPLEBOROUGH GREEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic in its entirety.

Reason for Order: To facilitate drainage investigation works and repairs.

Order Commences: 19 October 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 30 October 2020.

Access & Diversion: A435 Birmingham Road.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

COUGHTON FIELDS LANE, ALCESTER

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Captains Hill to a point outside Coughtonfields Farm.

Reason for Order: To facilitate cabling & splicing works and excavation of blockages.

Order Commences: 3 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 09 November 2020.

Access & Diversion: Coughton Fields Lane, Birmingham Road, Arden Road, Tything Road West, Kinwarton Farm Road, Kinwarton Road, Captains Hill and vice versa.

RAGLEY MILL LANE, ALCESTER

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Birmingham Road.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for the installation of polyduct in the carriageway.

Order Commences: 30 October 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 3 November 2020.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A4023 COVENTRY HIGHWAY, STUDLEY) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020 AND THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A4023 COVENTRY HIGHWAY, STUDLEY) (PROHIBITION OF U-TURNS) ORDER 2020

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to:-

(i) impose a 50-mph speed limit on the length of roads described in Schedule 1 below; and

(ii) prohibit U-Turns as described in Schedule 2 below.

The Order commences on Monday 16 November 2020.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1 **(50 mph Speed Limit)**

A4023 Coventry Highway, Studley

1. A4023 Coventry Highway (eastbound towards northbound slip)

From the Worcestershire/Warwickshire County boundary, eastwards for 246 metres towards the northbound slip onto the A435 Birmingham Road.

2. A4023 Coventry Highway (eastbound towards southbound slip)

From the Worcestershire/Warwickshire County boundary, eastwards for 444 metres towards the southbound slip onto the A435 Birmingham Road.

3. A4023 Coventry Highway (westbound)

From a point at the transition on the northbound slip from the A435 Birmingham Road onto the A4023 Coventry Highway, extending westwards for 463 metres to the Warwickshire/Worcestershire County boundary.

SCHEDULE 2 **(Prohibition of U Turns)**

A4023 Coventry Highway, Studley

From the A4023 Coventry Highway eastbound carriageway onto the westbound carriageway at the newly constructed signalised junction of the A4023 Coventry Highway near to the Warwickshire/Worcestershire County boundary.
