

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C204 BIRMINGHAM ROAD, C204 PRIORY ROAD & D5375 SCHOOL ROAD, ALCESTER

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows:

Birmingham Road/Priory Road, Alcester – closed from Icknield Row to a point o/s No. 79 Priory Road.

School Road, Alcester – closed from Priory Road to junction with Ropewalk (o/s No.30).
