ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CASTLE ROAD/HARDWICK LANE, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions to Riverside and Hardwick Lane.

Reason for Order: To enable cabling works.

Order Commences: 12 April 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 13 April 2021.

Access & Diversion: Castle Road, Alcester Road, Priory Square, Birmingham Road, Henley Road, Hardwick Lane (and vice versa).

WATTS ROAD, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Bromsgrove Road and Alcester Road.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new water connection.

Order Commences: 15 April 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 19 April 2021.

Access & Diversion: Watts Road, Bromsgrove Road, Holt Road, Alcester Road and vice versa.

NEW ROAD, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new domestic gas service.

Order Commences: 26 April 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 29 April 2021.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Alcester Road, Church Street and vice versa.

PRATTS LANE, MAPPLEBOROUGH GREEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Birmingham Road (from a point outside Quietways).

Reason for Order: To enable essential utility works.

Order Commences: 27 April 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 29 April 2021.

Access & Diversion: Birmingham Road, Pratts Lane and vice versa.

Contractor: For Severn Trent Water, Morrison Utility Services, Tel: 0800 783 4444.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
